## Asia

### China

#### **Hong Kong – [University of Hong Kong \(Exchange\)](#)**

The University of Hong Kong is the territory's oldest institute of higher learning and also an internationally recognized, research-led, comprehensive university. With over 7.4 million people of various nationalities in a 426 sq mi territory, Hong Kong is one of the most densely populated places in the world. Accounting students might be interested in classes such as Introduction to Financial Accounting, Business Law, and Big Data Economics.

### Taiwan

#### **Taipei – [Tamkang University \(Exchange\)](#)**

Tamkang University is located in New Taipei City, which is a city of about 4 million. Tamkang is a university dedicated to ideas, vision, and creativity. Accounting majors could take beginner classes like: Economics, Accounting, and AI and Programming Language.

## Europe

### Hungary

#### **Budapest - [AIFS Abroad in Budapest](#)**

Corvinus University is the leading higher education institution in Hungary. Its Hungarian students go through a rigorous academic selection and its international students come from over 80 countries around the world. Hungary has a long tradition of higher education and has produced many Nobel prize winners, scientists and inventors. Some courses include Elements of Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Introduction to International Business, and Marketing.

### Italy

#### **Rome - [SAI Programs - John Cabot University](#)**

John Cabot University is located in the Trastevere neighborhood of Rome, which is one of the city's oldest and most lively areas, abundant with art and excellent outdoor restaurants enjoyed by both Romans and visitors. JCU offers students the opportunity to pursue an exceptional academic and cultural education in the heart of Rome. Some courses for Accounting majors include Financial Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Business Communications, and International Business.

The American University of Rome is the oldest university of American degree-granting status in the Eternal City of Rome. Each student who attends AUR utilizes some part of the resources of Rome to enhance their learning experience, whether it be contemporary culture, politics, history, art, or spaces of this ancient city. Take courses at AUR like Financial Accounting, Managerial Accounting, Computer Applications for Business, and Introduction to International Business.

### United Kingdom

#### **Edinburgh – [CIS Abroad Semester in Edinburgh](#)**

Edinburgh Napier University is rapidly becoming the most modern and advanced university in Scotland. The campuses comprise of buildings from the sixteenth to the twenty-first century, reflecting Edinburgh Napier University's profile as a modern

university grounded in a solid tradition as a provider of higher learning. Some courses include Advanced Corporate Reporting, Auditing, International Accounting, among many others.

**Stirling – [CIS Abroad Semester in Stirling](#)**

Take Accounting courses (modules) like Critical Analysis of Accounting and Finance, Advanced Financial Accounting, Applied Management Accounting, among others.

**Australia**

**Adelaide – [IFSA - University of Adelaide](#)**

The University of Adelaide is located right in the heart of the city of Adelaide, which was recently called "Australia's best kept secret" thanks to its great weather, never-ending festivals, food and wine culture and affordability. Take Accounting courses like Accounting Foundations, Cost and Management Accounting, Accounting Information Systems, Accounting Theory, and Strategic Management Accounting.

**Gold Coast – [IFSA - Griffith University](#)**

Study at one of the Asia-Pacific region's most progressive and dynamic universities offering a wide range of studies and many interdisciplinary offerings. Study Abroad students who attend this program are eligible for Griffith's prestigious Honours College. Some of the courses available here are Principles of Accounting and Analytics, Management Accounting and Strategy, Accounting Theory and Company Accounting, and Corporate Finance.

**New Zealand**

**Dunedin - [API Full Curriculum at University of Otago in Dunedin](#)**

The University of Otago has been rated by international students as one of the top universities in New Zealand in terms of quality of learning, living, support, and student services. Students will study alongside "Kiwis" and other international students at New Zealand's oldest university. Take Accounting courses like Financial Accounting and Reporting, Accounting and Information Systems, Management Accounting, and Sustainability Accounting and Reporting.

**Wellington - [API Full Curriculum at Victoria University of Wellington](#)**

Students at Victoria University of Wellington (VUW) will be able to take a wide variety of courses with Kiwis and other international students in one of New Zealand's most comfortable cosmopolitan cities. Located in the capital, VUW offers top-level academics with a strong focus on regional issues. Some of the courses available here include Financial Accounting, Introduction to Accounting Systems, Fraud Auditing, Management Accounting, and Government Accounting and Finance.

## FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS

Faculty-led programs are short-term study abroad programs led by WSU faculty. These programs take place over breaks (winter, spring, or summer) and students earn 3-6 WSU credits. ### Europe

#### **Poland - [Economics of Poland](#)**

3 credits for BUSA 377. Takes place during Summer (14-16 days in May). Students will learn, through studying theories and through practical experiences, the concepts relative to international aspects of economics.

#### **Portugal and Spain - [Sports Management and Law in Portugal and Spain](#)**

3 credits in BUSA 377. Takes place during Winter Break (10-13 days in December/January). Students will examine the legal, financial, moral, and policy issues and disputes that arise in the world of amateur and professional sports.

#### **Scotland - [Going Green: The Impact of Sustainability on International Business and Culture in Scotland](#)**

3 credits for BUSA 377. Takes place during Summer (12-16 days in May or June). Students will study the impact of sustainability on business and culture in an international context.

### South America

#### **Argentina and Uruguay – [Problem Solving in Business: A Tango Through Argentina and Uruguay](#)**

3 credits for ACCT 380. Takes place during Summer (10-12 days in July/August). Students will research tourism-based businesses and use critical thinking skills to find potential problems and solutions using a global perspective.

Interning abroad is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable cross-cultural work experience, understand international perspectives in your field, and live in another country for a summer or semester. All internships are taken for credit, allowing financial aid to be used.
