United Kingdom

Aberdeen - [University of Aberdeen](#)

Music at Aberdeen is a wonderful opportunity to learn, compose and perform with world-renowned composers, conductors, musicologists, and researchers working in all genres, styles, and periods. They offer 51 Music courses including Music Diagnostics, Intro to Music Theory, and Intro to Contemporary Composition.

Edinburgh - [CIS Abroad Semester in Edinburgh – Edinburgh Napier University](#)

Edinburgh Napier University is rapidly becoming the most modern and advanced university in Scotland. The campuses are comprised of buildings from the 16th to the 21st century, reflecting Edinburgh Napier University's profile as a modern university grounded in a solid tradition as a provider for higher learning. Japan

Tokyo, Kyoto, Osaka - [Old Meets New: Timeless Japan](#)

3 credits: GS 320. GS 320 counts toward **Goal Area 5**. Takes place during Summer (13 days in May). Students will experience the modern way of life in Japan. They will analyze Japanese pop culture, its origins, and how it evolved since WWII.

Europe

Czech Republic and Hungary

Budapest, Prague - [Cities of Fairytales: Prague and Budapest](#)

6 credits: ART 313 (3 credits) and ART 398 (3 credits). ART 313 counts toward **Goal Areas 6B and 8**. Takes place during Summer (18-22 days in May/June). Students complete intensive reading, lecture, studio art practice (design, photography, drawing and painting), group discussions, field trips, and art and design projects to learn and understand contemporary European society.

Auckland, Christchurch, Queenstown, Wellington - [Made From Mountains: The Arts and Landscape of New Zealand](#)

3 credits for ART 313. ART 313 counts for **Goal Areas 6B and 8**. Takes place during Summer (21-26 days in May/June). Students will study New Zealand art and film, read New Zealand literature, and explore how the physical landscape itself so profoundly shaped ideas of what it meant to be from these remote South Pacific islands.

Interning abroad is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable cross-cultural work experience, understand international perspectives in your field, and live in another country for a summer or semester. BARCELONA SAE

Placement example: Music school that aims to provide a reasonable comprehensive learning base. They introduce students to the interpretation and practice of music, allowing them to enjoy the art, in listening, performing, and appreciating compositions. The school conducts two evaluations per semester, which serve to verify objectives met through personalized plans. Students are invited to hear and/or perform in concerts throughout the course. Tasks:

- Conduct tests, observing and evaluating the level of the students
- Create, run and manage a music workshop for children from 7 to 12 year and/or for teens and adults
- Possibility to teach private classes
- Perform school reception tasks
